Our MSc Practitioner in Psychological Trauma has been developed in partnership with the **Centre of Developmental and Complex Trauma, St Andrew's Healthcare** and listed for accreditation by the **British Psychological Society (BPS)** to provide expert understanding and professional competencies in psychological Trauma Informed Care.

Developing specialist trauma and trauma informed services has become key strategic and clinical aims within the NHS and healthcare sector based on the increasing awareness of trauma and the needs of people requiring specialised care with traumatic backgrounds.

Our part-time, two-year programme will provide health professionals with the theoretical understanding and professional competencies to develop, provide and lead psychological trauma services and trauma informed care models, for different populations with wide ranging trauma needs.

The structure and content of the MSc follows the level three 'trauma expert' competencies outlined by the BPS.

Teaching will be delivered at the Centre of Developmental and Complex Trauma, St Andrew's Healthcare, Northampton with practical application expected within the learners own environment.
