We provide specialist secure and locked care for men and women, particularly those with behaviour that challenges or a history of aggression.

- providing a high level of therapeutic activity
- sharing positive experiences in our inspiring, 120 acres of green space and the other facilities our site offers.

- We provide an individualised programme of treatment which incorporates the principles of the RAID model - positive, meaningful engagement and reinforcement. This effective approach makes a real difference - delivering reductions in overt aggression and incidents of behaviours that challenge.
- We use **Dementia Care Mapping** as a key performance indicator. This process is internationally recognised for promoting a holistic approach to improving life for each individual because it evaluates the quality of the care being provided from the perspective of the person with dementia.
